

Privacy Policy

1. Online registration relating to the einfracentral.eu website

This website offers you the possibility of registering to become part of the eInfraCentral community. While registering your personal data will be collected and further processed for the purposes detailed hereafter under point 2. The relevant processing operations thereof and the website are under the responsibility of the ArtWhere, acting as the Controller.

As this online service collects and further processes personal data, Regulation (EC) 45/2001, of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data, is applicable.

2. What personal information do we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means?

The personal data collected and further processed are data necessary for the organisation and management of the website and organisation of events to which users may decide to register using the einfracentral.eu website. As the **eInfraCentral** website functions on the basis of membership, it should be noted that the name and surname of members are associated to all posts, blogs, comments, etc. on the web site. Upon registering to events managed directly by **eInfraCentral**, the following details will be published in the on-line participants list open for public view: First Name, Surname, Affiliation, Country.

The processing operations on personal data linked to the organisation and management of this website is necessary for the management and functioning of the **eInfraCentral**, as mandated by the treaties, and more specifically articles 5, 7 and 211 - 219 of the EC Treaty.

3. Who has access to your information and to whom is it disclosed?

The information collected in the context of this website is only granted through User Id/Password to a defined population of users, namely everybody who has become member of the **eInfraCentral** community. No personal data is transmitted to other parties.

4. How do we protect and safeguard your information?

The collected personal data and all information related to the above mentioned web tool is stored on a computer of the external contractor, acting as processor, who has to guarantee the data protection and confidentiality required by the Regulation (EC) 45/2001.

Access to all collected personal data and all information related to the above mentioned meeting is only possible to the above described populations with a User Id/Password.

5. How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

If you register for one of **eInfraCentral** events we may collect, depending on the nature of the event, the following information from you or someone within your organisation:

- Name
- Organisation or affiliation
- Email address
- Address
- Contact telephone number
- Job title (when requested)
- Payment information (when requested)
- Dietary requirements (optional)
- Any special requirements (optional)
- Specific accessibility requirements (optional)
- Level of education and/or prior knowledge (optional)

During the event, **eInfraCentral** may capture some collective and individual images, audio or video recordings, and collect information provided by others (especially during training sessions), to evaluate your performance as a speaker or as a trainer. We could also make and store a recording of your voice in certain instances. **eInfraCentral** may use this information, including your personal data, in online communication channels such as social media pages, websites and blogs.

If you are a speaker at one of our events, we will also collect information including your name, institution/company and contact information. We may invite you to provide more information about you. **eInfraCentral** will keep this information available on its websites or wiki pages for an indefinite period of time for educational purposes, but you are able to delete your own personal data at any time.

This information, that could include pictures and an abbreviated biography (optional in both cases, and always provided by you), is managed by **eInfraCentral**. Rectification and removal requests can be submitted to the **eInfraCentral** staff member responsible for the event, or, depending on the event, may be edited directly and managed via your account.

eInfraCentral relies on a legitimate interest for collecting, storing and processing the information mentioned above.

During or after the event, **eInfraCentral** might contact you to collect your feedback about your experience, ascertain event impact or manage a post-event collaboration. For this purpose, **eInfraCentral** may collect additional personal data such as gender, level of education, age group. This personal data will be anonymised and will be used for the purposes of reporting and statistics.
